- Copy of the Aptitude and Achievement test for graduates from the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

- 3. Valid Civil ID copy.
- 4. Three photograph (4x6).
- 5. Applicants must register for IUK's English Placement Test or submit one of the following

#### **Self-Fund Students:**

- 60 % or equivalent to 2.0 for the College of Arts and College of Business
- -70% or equivalent to 2.5 for the College of Engineering
- •IELTS English Certificate (Minimum score required is 6)
- •TOEFL iPT English Certificate (Minimum score required is 60)

# What is My Study Load?

- Newly admitted: 12-13 credits (4 courses).
- Current students: 12-18 credits.
- Probation students: GPA less than 2.00 a maximum of 12 credits (4 courses).

# Is Attendance Mandatory?

Yes. to successfully pass courses, you must attend all classes.

- In credit courses, you will get FA if you exceed 9 hours of absence.
- For Foundation courses, you are allowed 40 hours of absence.

# What is a Degree Structure?:

All degree programs offered by the IUK have been approved by the Private Universities Council (PUC), and the structure of the degree programs is based on courses, each of which has an assigned number of credits. Each degree has specific requirements and a number of credits that students have to complete in order to award the degree.

# What is Course Credit System?:

The study system at IUK is based on credit hour course system, which is built on defining the number of study credits that must be successfully completed at the level provided for in the bylaw as a condition for graduation.

# **General Education Requirements?:**

General education courses are required of all students. The courses are in a number of academic areas (natural sciences, communication, humanities, social sciences, Islamic civilization, Kuwait history, and mathematics).
